VISIT TO VIGYAN BHAWAN

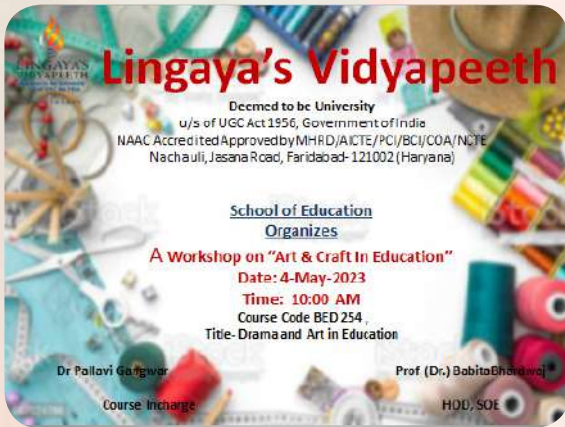

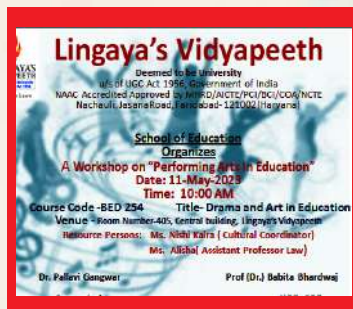
ART AND CRAFT IN EDUCATION
