#### Minutes of the BOS (Pharmacy) Meeting held on 31/05/2019

A meeting of Board of Studies of School of Pharmacy was held on 31.05.2019 at Room No. CS2422, Computing Block, Lingaya's Vidyapeeth, Faridabad. Following members were present:

The HOD, Pharmacy extended a warm welcome to all the Hon'ble members. At the outset, he gave a brief account of the core activities of the School of Pharmacy to strengthen academics. After confirming the quorum of the meeting, the agenda of the meeting was taken up for discussion. The summary of the discussions and decisions taken on the agenda items during the meeting is as under:

1. The members of the Board reviewed in minute details the implementation of "The Bachelor of Pharmacy (B.Pharm) Course Regulations, 2014 now termed as "The Revised Regulations for the B. Pharm. Degree Program (CBCS) of the Pharmacy Council of India, New Delhi" adopted & implemented from Batch 2017-18 at Lingaya's Vidyapeeth. The members expressed satisfaction on implementation of the following new courses in totality:

- 2. The Board re-affirmed to continue the Course curriculum for Diploma in Pharmacy in accordance with the regulations of the Pharmacy Council of India (Education Regulations 1992) as already enforced at Lingaya's Vidyapeeth.
- 3. HOD (Pharmacy) apprised the Board about Industrial Internship of the first batch (2015-19) of B.Pharmacy. He informed that all the 8<sup>th</sup> Semester B.Pharm students have completed 4 months internship and training in pharmaceutical industries.
- 4. HOD (Pharmacy) put before the board members the Panel of Examiners for Question Paper setting and conduct of Practical Examinations, which was approved by the Board.
- 5. Status of Ph.D research scholars was presented by the HOD, and the Board members expressed satisfaction and appreciation of the ongoing research work. It was placed on record that three research scholars have been awarded PhD in 2018-19 academic session, 09 research papers and 03 copyrights have been secured during this span.
- 6. The future plan of action of the Department was discussed as below:

It was recommended to purchase equipment for School of Pharmacy as per PCI requirements and especially as per requirements list submitted by HOD to Stores Department in March 2018.

It was recommended to purchase books and softwares for yearly addition (150 books per year) as per PCI requirements at the earliest.

7. The members were apprised about Industrial Visit of B.Pharm students to Industrial plant of Yakult Danone Ltd at Sonepat, Haryana on 28th March, 2019. School of Pharmacy organized a day trip to Surajkund Crafts Mela 2019 at Faridabad on 15th February, 2019 for D.Pharmacy and B.Pharmacy students. Science Familiarization Trip was organized for D.Pharmacy students at National Science Center, New Delhi on 12th March, 2019. Medicinal Plants Identification Trip was conducted for B.Pharmacy students at Mughal Gardens, Rashtrapati Bhawan, New Delhi on 08th March, 2019.

More Industrial Visits are being planned for B.Pharm students to give them a closer experience of drug manufacturing, and a medicinal plants excursion trip is also in planning in the next semester for B.Pharm students.



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- 8. HOD, Pharmacy informed the Board that yearly proposal for approval for 2019-20 has been submitted to Pharmacy Council of India in Online mode in January, 2019. The members expressed satisfaction for the timely compliance of policies of PCI, and discussed about the preparations for PCI Inspection.
- 9. Planning of a conference/seminar to be organized by the department was discussed in the meeting. The Department shall apply to funding agencies for conference grant.
- 10. Inclusion of Digital Teaching and Learning is very important to keep pace with emerging technologies and concepts, keeping this in view, special emphasis was given on creating facilities in the department for effective Digital T&L process.

Before concluding the meeting, Special emphasis was again given on completing requirements of Glassware, Chemicals, Books and Equipment as per PCI norms at the earliest.
