

NOTIFICATION

Whereas the Central Government is empowered under Section 3 of the University Grants Commission (UGC) Act, 1956 to declare, on the advice of the UGC, an Institution of Higher Learning as an institution "deemed-to-be-university".

2. And whereas, an application was received in April 2005 from Lingaya's Institute of Management & Technology, Faridabad seeking declaration as an institution 'deemed-to-be-university' under Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956;
3. And whereas, the University Grants Commission has examined the said proposal and vide its communication bearing No.6-32/2006(CPP-I) dated the 13th August 2008 has recommended the Central Government to declare Lingaya's Institute of Management & Technology, Faridabad an institution 'deemed-to-be-university', subject to review after five years;
4. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956, the Central Government, on the advice of the University Grants Commission (UGC), hereby declare that Lingaya's Institute of Management & Technology, Faridabad shall be an institution "deemed-to-be-university", in the name and style of 'Lingaya's University', for the purposes of the aforesaid Act, subject to a review after five years, with effect from the date of its disaffiliation from its affiliating university, viz., Maharshi Dayanand University, Rohtak, Haryana;
5. The declaration that Lingaya's Institute of Management & Technology, Faridabad is an institution 'deemed-to-be-a-university', shall be confirmed after a period of five years on the basis of the aforesaid review by an Expert Committee of the UGC and recommendations of the Commission thereof;

6. The declaration as made in para 4 above is subject to fulfillment / compliance of further conditions mentioned at Sr. No.4 of the endorsement to this Notification;
7. Neither the Government of India nor the UGC shall provide any Plan or Non-Plan grant-in-aid to the Lingaya's Institute of Management & Technology, Faridabad / Lingaya's University.

- (ii) All the movable and immovable assets and properties shall be legally vested with the Lingaya's University, Faridabad viz. the society formed to manage the 'deemed-to-be-university' institution, in the interest of future of students, members of faculty, employees and for maintaining the standards of higher education.
- (iii) There shall be no diversion of assets of the society/ institution 'deemed-to-be-university' without the prior permission of the UGC.
- (iv) The accounts of the Lingaya's University, Faridabad shall be open to inspection by the UGC.
- (v) The society concerned should continue to maintain the corpus fund as per the norms of the UGC and the said fund should be irrevocable in nature. The society shall accordingly take necessary action in consultation with the UGC to ensure irrevocability of the corpus fund.
- (vi) The objectives of the society / 'deemed-to-be-university' institution should confine to educational and related social and charitable activities. The society as well as the institution concerned should not undertake or engage in any activity that is of commercial and profit making nature.
- (vii) It is not permissible for Lingaya's University, Faridabad to affiliate any teaching institution.
- (viii) The Lingaya's University, Faridabad shall submit a legal undertaking to cover the issues pertaining to earmarking of assets, non-diversion of assets without prior approval of the UGC and for providing powers / authority to the UGC to take control of assets, etc. of the 'deemed-to-be-university' institution concerned in the event of winding up of or dissolution of the said Institution.
- (ix) As and when necessary, the Trust concerned shall update or revise or modify the MoA / Rules of Lingaya's University, Faridabad with the approval of the UGC. Further, specific changes/amendments, if any, suggested by the Government of India or by the UGC, shall also be carried out in the MoA/Rules with the approval of the UGC.
- (x) The MoA/Rules/Regulations/Bye-laws of the society concerned should reflect the name of the teaching institution that forms part of the deemed-to-be-university institution concerned.


- (xi) The Lingaya's University, Faridabad shall offer only those academic courses that conform to the norms and standards prescribed by the relevant Statutory Bodies such as the UGC, AICTE etc. The professional courses that the applicant institution offers should also have the approval of the respective Statutory Regulatory Councils.
- (xii) The Lingaya's University, Faridabad shall not award any degree that is not specified by the UGC. It shall also ensure that the nomenclatures of the degrees, etc. to be awarded by it are specified by the UGC under Section 22 of the UGC Act, 1956.
- (xiii) The Lingaya's University, Faridabad shall take immediate steps to start doctoral programmes and innovative courses and also to strengthen/augment its research programmes/activities.
- (xiv) The Lingaya's University, Faridabad shall start new academic courses only as per the norms prescribed by the UGC, AICTE and other Statutory Councils concerned, as the case may be.
- (xv) The Lingaya's University, Faridabad shall award degrees in respect of its approved academic courses / programmes, only to those students that are admitted to the Institution subsequent to the date of this notification.
- (xvi) As for the students who were already admitted and enrolled in Lingaya's Institute of Management & Technology, Faridabad (now Lingaya's University, Faridabad) prior to the date of this notification, they shall continue to pursue their courses of study under enrolment and affiliation of the affiliating university concerned, viz., Maharshi Dayanand University, Rohtak that shall conduct examinations for them and award degrees to them upon successful completion of the courses/programmes of study which such students are presently pursuing at the said institute / college.
- (xvii) The Lingaya's University, Faridabad shall not conduct any distance education programme without prior approval of the UGC and the Distance Education Council (DEC). The guidelines issued by both the DEC and the UGC from time to time in the matter of imparting education through distance mode shall have to be complied with by it.
- (xviii) The Lingaya's University, Faridabad / the society concerned shall not start and / or run any study centre / extension centre / off-campus centre / off-shore campus without obtaining the requisite prior approval of the UGC/ Government of India; as the case may be.

- (xix) All the prescribed norms and procedures of the relevant Statutory Councils, such as UGC, AICTE, etc. and of other authorities concerned in the matter of admission of students, intake capacity of students, starting of new courses/ programmes, renewal of approval to the courses, etc. will continue to be in force, and shall be adhered to by Lingaya's University, Faridabad.

- (xxi) The Lingaya's University, Faridabad should take immediate steps to rectify the shortcomings/deficiencies observed by the AICTE's Expert Team in relation to library space, faculty with PhD qualification, regular full-time PhD scholars to promote quality research, sponsored research and R & D projects from industry and other funding agencies to further strengthen the existing marginal industrial collaboration.
- (xxii) Suggestions and recommendations of the UGC's Expert Committee including that of the representative of the AICTE should be complied with by the Lingaya's University, Faridabad so as to bring about the recommended improvement.
- (xxiii) The Lingaya's University, Faridabad shall abide by all the norms and guidelines as laid down by the UGC, AICTE and other Statutory Councils concerned from time to time, as are applicable to institutions notified as 'Deemed-to-be-Universities'.
- (xxiv) The Lingaya's University, Faridabad shall not create an impression in the mind of the general public that the 'deemed-to-be-university' institution has been 'established' under a Central Act. In order to ensure this, Lingaya's University, Faridabad in all its advertisements, public notices, communications, etc., shall distinctly mention under its nomenclature by inserting (within brackets) a line, which shall read: "*Declared as Deemed-to-be-University" under Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956*".

The Government of India, Ministry of Human Resource Development, on the advice of University Grants Commission has declared Lingaya's Institute of Management & Technology, Faridabad, Haryana vide notification No.F.9-23/2005-U.3 dated 5th January, 2009.

The declaration is also subject to further conditions mentioned below:-

- (i) The management of Lingaya's Institute of Management & Technology, Faridabad, Haryana shall legally vest with the Society created for the purpose of obtaining status of 'deemed-to-be-university', i.e. Lingaya's University, Faridabad.
- (ii) All the movable and immovable assets and properties shall be legally vested with the Lingaya's University, Faridabad viz. the society formed to manage the 'deemed-to-be-university' institution, in the interest of future of students, members of faculty, employees and for maintaining the standards of higher education.



NOTIFICATION

Whereas, the Central Government is empowered under Section 3 of the University Grants Commission (UGC) Act, 1956 to declare, on the advice of the UGC, an Institution of higher learning as deemed to be University.

2. **And whereas**, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956, the Central Government vide its Notification No.9-23/2005-U3 dated 05.01.2009, on the advice of UGC, had declared Lingaya's Institute of Management & Technology, Faridabad as deemed to be University in the name & style of 'Lingaya's University' for the provisional period of five years, with effect from the date on which the aforesaid Institute disaffiliates itself from its affiliating University viz. Maharshi Dayanand University, Rohtak, Haryana. This was subject to condition that the status of deemed to be University shall be confirmed after the period of 5 years based on the inspection and assessment report of UGC's Expert Review Committee and the recommendations of the UGC thereon.


3. **And whereas**, UGC is in the process of reviewing the functioning of Lingaya's University (Deemed to be University), Faridabad as required by this Ministry's Notification dated 05.01.2009.

4. **And further whereas**, the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India vide its judgment Order dated 03.11.2017 in Civil Appeal Nos. 17869-17870/2017 (arising out of SLP(C) Nos.19807-19808/2012) filed by Orissa Lift Irrigation Corp. Ltd Versus Rabi Sankar Patro & Ors. and Civil Appeal Nos.17902-17905/2017 (arising out of SLP C Nos.35793-96/2012) titled as Vijay Kumar & Ors Vs. Kartar Singh & Ors held that UGC shall take appropriate steps for implementing Section 23 of the UGC Act and restraining Deemed to be Universities from using the word 'University' within one month from today.

5. And whereas, Section 23 of the UGC Act, 1956 says "no institution, whether a corporate body or not, other than a University established or incorporated by or under a Central Act, a Provincial Act or a State Act shall be entitled to have the word "University" associated with its name in any manner whatsoever: Provided that nothing in this section shall, for a period of two years from the commencement of this Act, apply to an institution which, immediately before such commencement, had the word "University" associated with its name".

6. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956, the Central Government, as per direction of Hon'ble Supreme Court, and on the advice of the UGC, do hereby change the name of "Lingaya's University", Faridabad, Haryana to "Lingaya's Vidyapeeth" by replacing the word 'University' with 'Vidyapeeth' w.e.f. the issuance of this Notification. "Lingaya's Vidyapeeth" shall not use the word 'University' suffixed to its name but may mention the words "deemed to be university" within parenthesis suffixed thereto.

7. The other conditions mentioned in the earlier Notification dated 05.01.2009 shall continue to be adhered by "Lingaya's Vidyapeeth".



1. The management shall provide adequate funds for development of land and related infrastructure, instructional and other facilities as per norms and standards laid down by the Council from time to time and for meeting recurring expenditure.
2. The Eligibility Criteria for admissions shall be made in accordance with the regulations notified by the Council in Approval Process Handbook.
3. The curriculum of the course, the procedure for evaluation / assessment of students may be in accordance with the Model Curriculum and Exam reforms prescribed by the AICTE from time to time.
4. The management of the Institution shall not discontinue any course(s) or start any new course(s) or alter intake capacity of seats without the prior approval of the Council.
5. No excess admission shall be made by the Institution over and above the approved intake under any circumstances. In case any excess admission is reported to the Council, appropriate action as per the notified regulations shall be initiated against the Institution.
6. The Institution shall not have any collaborative arrangements with any other Indian and / or Foreign Universities for conduct of technical courses without obtaining prior approval from AICTE. In case any violation is reported to the Council, appropriate action as per the notified regulations shall be initiated against the Institution.
7. The Institution shall operate only from the approved location, and that the institution shall not open any off campus study centers / extension centers directly or in collaboration with any other institution / university / organization for the purpose of imparting technical education without obtaining prior approval from the AICTE. If found so, appropriate action as per the notified regulations shall be initiated against the Institution.
8. The accounts of the Institution shall be got audited annually by a certified Chartered Accountant by the institute and shall be open for inspection by the Council or persons authorized by it.
9. The Heads of Departments, the teaching and other staff shall be appointed in given time frame and selection shall be done according to procedures, qualifications and experience prescribed by the Council from time to time and pay scales shall be as per the norms prescribed by the UGC/AICTE from time to time.
10. The Institution shall publish an information booklet before commencement of the academic year giving details regarding the Institution and courses / programs being conducted, academic calendar, fees charged and details of infrastructural facilities including faculty etc. in the form of mandatory disclosure on the Institute Website. The information shall be revised every year with updated information about all aspects of the Institute.
11. If the Institution fails to disclose the information or suppresses and / or misrepresents the information, appropriate action as per the notified regulations shall be initiated against the Institution.
12. AICTE may also conduct inspections with or without notifying the dates to verify specific complaints, to verify adherence to AICTE norms & standards, and to verify any mis-representation, violation of norms & standards, mal-practices etc.
13. The Institution by virtue of the approval given by Council shall not automatically become claimant to any grant-in-aid from the Central or State Government.
14. In the event of a student / candidate cancelling the admission before the starting of the course, the wait listed candidates should be given admission against the vacant seats. The entire fee collected from the student, after a deduction of the processing fee of not more than Rs. 1000/- (Rupees one thousand only) shall be refunded to the student / candidate withdrawing from the program. It would not be permissible for the Institute to retain the School / Institution Leaving Certificates in original to force retention of admitted students and not to charge fees for the remaining period if a student cancels the admission at any point of time.

15. The Institution shall take appropriate measures for prevention of ragging in any form, in the light of AICTE regulation "Prevention and Prohibition of Ragging in Technical Institutions, Universities including Deemed to Universities imparting technical education" Regulation 2009 (F.No. 37-3/Legal/AICTE/2009 dated 01/07/2009). In case of failure to prevent the instances of ragging by the Institution, the Council shall take appropriate action as per the notified regulations.
16. Institution shall not conduct any UG/ PG/ Diploma Level Courses/ Programmes as mentioned in the Approval Process Hand Book through Distance Education/ ODL mode.

The Institution shall strictly follow further conditions as may be specified by the Council from time to time. The Council may withdraw the approval, in case it observes any violation of the above conditions and / or non-adherence to the norms and standards prescribed by the Council, mis-representation of facts and submitting factually incorrect information to it.



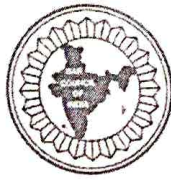

However, this approval is accorded only for the academic year 2021-2022. It is further made clear that this will apply only in case where affiliation has been granted by the University. Such provisional approval by Bar Council of India shall be subject to any decision taken after the inspection of the Centre of Legal Education is done by the Bar Council of India subsequently.

As per the circular dated 05.02.2020 bearing No.BCI:D:158 (LE:Circulation No.01/2020), issued to all Centers of Legal education, and as per the extended time for such compliance (The Council has extended the time for such compliance to 15th April, 2022), every center of Legal Education/college shall be required to submit a certified authenticated bank statement bearing bank stamp, date and signature, mandatorily with respect to the salary/ies being disbursed to all the teachers/faculties every three months from date of receipt of communication on a regular basis, unless specifically sought at other intervals.

The Centers of Legal Education shall also furnish list of teachers with qualifications as per BCI and UGC Rules, and further furnish proof/receipts of fulfillment of minimum library requirements, as enumerated under Schedule-III, Rule-15, Minimum Library requirements of Legal Education Rules-which is the sine qua non of a Center of Legal Education. Show cause notices had also been issued specifically to certain Centers of Legal Education/Colleges, with conditions mentioned therein to be complied with immediately.

It is made clear that if any Center of Legal Education, fails to submit all the required documents as sought by way of the referred circular and the show cause notices (where applicable), within the stipulated/extended time for such compliance, then application for extension of approval for 2022-2023 of such Centers of Legal Education shall not be considered and, if, approval is granted for the academic session 2021-2022 by way of any reason whatsoever, then it may be withdrawn too.

The Center/s of Legal Education/College may take a note of the above mentioned facts and furnish compliance of the same and of the other rules and regulations of Legal Education, including the stipulations specified in ANNEXURE-A, attached to this provisional approval of affiliation letter. This is required to be complied with by/on/before 15.04.2022 with adequate documentary proof(s) and by way of a notarized affidavit. In case of failure of compliance by any Center of Legal Education their application for extension of approval for 2022-23 shall not be considered and if approval is granted for the academic session 2021-2022, the same may be liable to be withdrawn too.



The University/college must send a duly notarized affidavit stating the details of faculty members including the Principal/ Head of Institution, and Head of Department specifying and certifying their qualifications and the subjects being taught by them and further stating the salary being paid to the faculty members by RTGS/NEFT/Cheque which must be as per UGC scale under Bankers Book of Evidence Act. Authenticated, signed and certified Bank Statements, have to be necessarily furnished to the Bar Council of India every three months.

For the present moment authenticated signed and certified Bank Statements bearing bank stamp/seal and signature of the bank manager for a period of three months with effect from the date of receipt of this letter for the preceding period of three months must be furnished immediately.

This must be continued to be submitted every three months without fail.

Furthermore, the library should be furnished as per Clause 15 of Schedule III of Legal Education Rules-2008 given below:-

“Minimum Library requirement: To start with, a Law Library shall have a set of AIR manual, Combo offer of CD of AIR Pvt. Ltd. (containing electronic version of AIR Supreme Court and High Court Data bases Research 1950-2015 (four connections each) Cr. L.J. Data Base 1950-2015 (four connections) AIR Privy Council Data Base 1900-1950 (four connections) AIR Mannual latest 6th Edition (1-45 Vols.) AIR Journal 2015, Cr. L.J. 2015, L.I.C. 2015, AIR Civil Cases 2015, AIR Law Lines 2015, AIR Cheque Dishonour Reports 2015, AIR Accident Claims and compensation 2015, Institution shall get electronic versions updated every year by AIR Pvt. Ltd. Central Acts and Local Acts, Criminal law journal, SCC, Company cases, Indian Bar Review, selected Judgements on Professional Ethics and Journals with the back volumes for at least ten years and also such number of text books in each subjects taught during the period according to the minimum standard ratio of ten books for each registered students. For running integrated program, text books of such other subjects are also to be kept in the similar minimum ratio. The institution should keep in mind that minimum 10 sets of Indian Bar Review, selected judgments and professional Ethics published by Bar Council of India Trust and the AIR volumes/set must be promptly ordered for the library if not already ordered, as it is an essential requirement to run a law college which is stipulated by Bar Council of India, Legal Education Rules 2008 framed under a Parliament Act.”

Further the College/University should ensure to follow Rule-10 of Legal Education Rules 2008 which is quoted hereunder.

10. Semester system

The course leading to either degree in law, unitary or on integrated double degree, shall be conducted in semester system in not less than 15 weeks for unitary degree course or not less than 18 weeks in double degree integrated course with not less than 30 class-hours per week including tutorials, moot court room exercise and seminars provided there shall be at least 24 lecture hours per week.

Provided further that in case of specialized and/or honours law courses there shall be not less than 36 class-hours per week including seminar, moot court and tutorial classes and 30 minimum lecture hours per week.

Provided further that Universities are free to adopt trimester system with appropriate division of courses per trimester with each of the trimester not less than 12 weeks.

Furthermore, a compliance affidavit in this regard too should be furnished.

A Compliance affidavit shall also be required to be furnished with respect to the follows: -

Rule -18 Minimum weekly class program per subject (paper):

There shall be for each paper (with 4 credit) Four class-hours for one hour duration each and one hour of tutorial/moot court/project work per week.

The College/University has also ensure to furnish compliance affidavit with regard to following Clause-24, Schedule-II of Legal Education Rule-2008 which lays down Moot Court exercises and Internship; rules Clause-25, Schedule-III lays down Minimum period of Internship which is quoted hereunder.

However, during the pandemic period, it has been left open to the University to choose any alternative mode with respect to the same, owing to practical feasibility of the same.

24. Moot court exercise and Internship:

This paper may have three components of 30 marks each and a viva for 10 marks.

(a) Moot Court (30 Marks). Every student may be required to do at least three moot courts in a year with 10 marks for each. The moot court work will be on assigned problem and it will be evaluated for 5 marks for written submissions and 5 marks for oral advocacy.

(b) Observance of Trial in two cases, one Civil and one Criminal (30 marks):

Students may be required to attend two trials in the course of the last two or three years of LL.B. studies. They will maintain a record and enter the various steps observed during their attendance on different days in the court assignment. This scheme will carry 30 marks.

(c) Interviewing techniques and Pre-trial preparations and Internship diary (30 marks):

Each student will observe two interviewing sessions of clients at the Lawyer's Office/Legal Aid Office and record the proceedings in a diary, which will carry 15 marks. Each student will further observe the preparation of documents and court papers by the Advocate and the procedure for the filing of the suit/petition. This will be recorded in the diary, which will carry 15 marks.

(d) The fourth component of this paper will be Viva Voce examination on all the above three aspects. This will carry 10 marks.

25. Minimum Period of Internship:

(a) Each registered student shall have completed minimum of twelve weeks internship for Three Year Course stream and twenty weeks in case of Five Year Course stream during the entire period of legal studies under NGO, Trial and Appellate Advocates, Judiciary, Legal Regulatory authorities, Legislatures and Parliament, Other Legal Functionaries, Market Institutions, Law Firms, Companies, Local Self Government and other such bodies as the University shall stipulate, where law is practiced either in action or in dispute resolution or in management.

Provided that internship in any year cannot be for a continuous period of more than Four Weeks and all


students shall at least gone through once in the entire academic period with Trial and Appellate Advocates.

(b) Each student shall keep Internship diary in such form as may be stipulated by the University concerned and the same shall be evaluated by the Guide in Internship and also a Core Faculty member of the staff each time. The total mark shall be assessed in the Final Semester of the course in the 4th Clinical course as stipulated under the Rules in Schedule II.

Kindly ensure to comply with all the above stipulated and all other requisite Rules of Legal Education 2008 by way of compliance by way of duly notarized affidavit by attaching adequate documentary proof with the same preferably within a period of 6 weeks/ till extended time for such compliance for being eligible to be issued further Approval for further subsequent academic years.

Sub: Fresh approval of affiliation to School of Law, Lingaya's University, Faridabad, Haryana for imparting five year BBA LL.B. integrated course with intake of one section of 60 students for a period of two years i.e. for Academic Year 2017-18 and 2018-19 and for three year LL.B course with intake of two section of 60 students in each section for a period of two years i.e. for the academic years 2017-2018 and 2018-2019 instead of 2016-2017 and 2017-2018.

Sir,

The Standing Committee (Sub-Committee) of the Legal Education Committee of the Bar Council of India at its meeting held on 1st and 2nd July, 2017 considered the inspection report of **School of Law, Lingaya's University, Faridabad, Haryana**. The Standing Committee considered the inspection report of School of Law, Lingaya's University, Faridabad, Haryana. After consideration, the Committee is of the view that School of Law, Lingaya's University, Faridabad, Haryana be granted fresh approval of affiliation for imparting **five year BBA LL.B. integrated course** with intake of **one section of 60 students** for a period of **two years** i.e. for academic year **2017-18** and **2018-19** subject to the following conditions.

So far three year law course is concerned, approval was granted for the academic year 2016-2017 and 2017-2018. But the University did not start the said course in the year 2016-2017, hence approval is extended for the academic year 2017-2018 and 2018-2019 with intake of two sections of 60 students in each section.

The University/College is directed to also fulfill the following conditions, failure of which may lead to subsequent necessary and proper action being taken in this regard.

1. The Institution is directed to establish the Legal Aid Centre as per Clause-11, Schedule-III of Rule-11 of the Part-IV of the Legal Education Rules - 2008.
2. Institution should ensure the payment of salary to teachers as per Rules 22 schedule III, Part IV of BCI Rules.
3. The institution is directed to upgrade the library as mentioned below :-

(Signature)

"Today with the increasing cost of journals, books, wi-fi, e-library and online facilities including I.T. facilities, the minimum investment by each university should be Rs. 10 lakhs for each year. However any university/deemed university in rural area, it should be Rs. 5 Lakh and for all other affiliated colleges in the urban area it should be Rs. 2 lakhs and in rural area Rs. 1 lakh."

4. The institution is also directed to upgrade the library by subscribing 10 sets of Indian Bar Review, selected judgments and professional Ethics published by Bar Council of India Trust.
5. Teacher Student ratio shall be as per Schedule-III, Rule-11, Clause-17, Part-IV of Bar Council of India Rules.
6. Institution is directed to inform the timings of the classes.
7. The Moot Court room should be modified as per the norms of the Bar Council of India having furniture for sitting Hon'ble Judge in Moot Court and sitting arrangements of participants.
8. College although have 40 computers for the School of Law, College should purchase 20 more computers for the law students.
9. The University is directed to open a saving in the name of School of Law, Lingaya's University to pay the salary of the faculty and other expenses from this account.

Further, the University/College must specify the timing of the college which has not been given. College should also maintain the timing which has to be minimum 5 ½ hours with half an hour break. College to file an affidavit to the Bar Council of India within six weeks mentioning the timing of the classes. The relevant rules are quoted hereunder :-

Rule (xxiii), Chapter I

"(xxiii) "Regular Course of Study" means and includes a course which runs for at least five hours a day continuously with an additional half an hour recess every day and running not less than thirty hours of working schedule per week."

Rule 5 of Schedule III

"Classes may be conducted between 8 a.m. to 7 p.m. in an Centre of Legal Education, which is not fully residential. However the Library may remain open till 10 p.m."

The library should be furnished as per Clause 15 of Schedule III of Legal Education Rules 2008 is given below :-

updated every year by AIR Pvt. Ltd. Central Acts and Local Acts, Criminal law journal, SCC, Company cases, Indian Bar Review, selected Judgements on Professional Ethics and Journals with the back volumes for at least ten years and also such number of text books in each subjects taught during the period according to the minimum standard ratio of ten books for each registered students. For running integrated program, text books of such other subjects are also to be kept in the similar minimum ratio.

Further, the institution should follow the attendance rule and file reply that they are following the aforesaid rule. The next inspection team must also see whether the said rule is being followed by the university or not. The relevant Rule 12 is given below :-

"12. End Semester Test: No student of any of the degree program shall be allowed to take the end semester test in a subject if the student concerned has not attended minimum of 70% of the classes held in the subject concerned as also the moot court room exercises, tutorials and practical training conducted in the subject taken together.

Provided that if a student for any exceptional reasons fail to attend 70% of the classes held in any subject, the Dean of the University or the Principal of the Centre of Legal Education, as the case may be, may allow the student to take the test if the student concerned attended at least 65% of the classes held in the subject concerned and attended 70% of classes in all the subjects taken together. The similar power shall rest with the Vice Chancellor or Director of a National Law University, or his authorized representative in the absence of the Dean of Law.

Provided further that a list of such students allowed to take the test with reasons recorded be forwarded to the Bar Council of India."

University/College should also admit students as per the below mentioned Rule:

7. Minimum marks in qualifying examination for admission: Bar Council of India may from time to time, stipulate the minimum percentage of marks not below 45% of the total marks in case of general category applicants, 42% for OBC category and 40% of the total marks in case of SC and ST applicants, to be obtained for the qualifying examination, such as 12 Examination in case of Integrated Five Years' course or Degree course in any discipline for Three years' LL.B. course, for the purpose of applying for and getting admitted into a Law Degree Program of any recognized University in either of the streams.


Provided that such a minimum qualifying marks shall not automatically entitle a person to get admission into an institution but only shall entitle the person concerned to fulfill other institutional criteria notified by the institution concerned or by the government concerned from time to time to apply for admission.

Institution should submit affidavit the compliance of the above conditions within six weeks.







During approval process for the academic year 2022-2023 for introduction of new pharmacy course(s) by existing institutions, the institution will have to apply on the portal along with requisite Pharmacy Education Regulatory Charges and submit the below mentioned documents mandatorily at the time of application for consideration of the application -
- i) For B.Pharm course
- a) Consent of affiliation of Examining Authority
b) NOC of the State Government
- In case, the State Government has done away with the issuance of NOC of the State Government for starting of pharmacy course, in that case institution shall upload the said communication from the State Government as a documentary evidence.
- ii) For D.Pharm / Pharm.D & Pharm.D (Post Baccalaureate) / new M.Pharm course and introduction of new M.Pharm specialization / B.Pharm (Practice) course
- a) Consent of affiliation of the Examining Authority
b) MOU with 300 bedded hospital (applicable for Pharm.D course) in the prescribed format, a copy of which is enclosed as Annexure-C.
5. Please note that -
- i) the above documents should be in English duly signed by the Principal and legible.
ii) in case the above documents are not submitted, the proposal for introduction of new course will not be entertained by the Council and will be summarily rejected.
iii) The procedure of submission of affidavit by existing institutions in lieu of submission of mandatory documents has been done away with and will no longer be accepted.
6. For raise in admissions
- i) Please note that number of admissions are restricted as per following details -
- | <u>Course</u> | <u>No. of admissions permitted</u> |
|--------------------|------------------------------------|
| D.Pharm | - 60 |
| B.Pharm | - 60 / 100 |
| M.Pharm | - 15 per specialization |

- ii) For consideration of raise in admissions wherever applicable, the institution shall apply for the same as per the provisions of the Regulations for consideration of the council, however the admissions for the raise which is being sought shall be done only after the approval of the PCI and the examining authority.
- iii) It will be the responsibility of the institution to obtain the consent of Examining Authority for raise in admission before making admission and submit to PCI.
- iv) In case, the institution fails to obtain and submit the consent of the Examining Authority for raise in admission, it shall not admit the students (for raise) failing which the consequences shall rest on the institution. The PCI in no way shall be responsible for the same.

7. For Services

Similarly the institutions applying for Services shall also mandatorily submit the statutory documents as prescribed in Annexure-B failing which application for services will be summarily rejected.

8. Pharmacy Education Regulatory Charges

For the payment of the Pharmacy Education Regulatory Charges multiple payment gateways are available and include payments through BillDesk, (NEFT/RTGS) and SBI.

9. Cautions

The following cautions shall be noted and exercised while submitting online application on PCI portal for consideration of approval for academic session 2022-2023.

- i) The Last date for completing the application process on PCI portal will not be extended under any circumstances and hence institutions are required to apply online in SIF without fail within the available window from 01.12.2021 to 15.12.2021.
The institutions are advised not to wait for the last date for submission of SIF as overcrowding may pose technical problems. The Council will not be responsible in case institution is not able to apply on time. It is reiterated that the last date will not be extended and no further time will be granted to complete the application process.
- ii) All Institutions that are already approved by the PCI for conduct of course / approved under section 12 for registration as a pharmacist for the D.Pharm / B.Pharm / M.Pharm / Pharm.D, Pharm.D (PB) / B.Pharm (Practice) programs have to mandatorily apply on the PCI portal, submitting all the requisite information and Pharmacy Education Regulatory Charges for consideration of approval.
- iii) Institutions already having approval for 2022-2023 or beyond 2022-2023 academic session shall also mandatorily apply in SIF and pay the mandatory Pharmacy Education Regulatory Charges for retention of already granted approval.
- iv) Applying for approval is entirely the responsibility of the institution and failure to apply will result in not being reflected in the approved list of Institutions on the Council's website leading to "No Admission Year".


- v) All fields in the SIF are to be mandatorily completed including -
- teaching staff details (Name, qualification, specialization at PG level (very important), Years of experience etc).
 - details of salary paid to teaching staff during the period of January 2021 to October 2021.
 - the staff names that are reflected in an institution, as per the PCI circular dt.9.10.2013, a copy of which is enclosed as **Annexure-D** will be not counted for the number of staff for the particular program if they have left the institution to join another institution in the same academic year.
 - the staff whose name is reflected in an institution presently for the academic year 2022-23 will not be given credit in another institution for the year 2022-23 even if they join another institution during the said period. Such information should be clearly informed by the faculty to the joining institution and the PCI. If any information is suppressed, the individual faculty will be responsible and can be debarred from teaching assignments for a period up to 3 years under statutory provisions of "Minimum Qualification for Teachers in Pharmacy Institutions Regulations, 2014".
 - the appointment of qualified principal and teaching staff as per the statutory provisions of various Education Regulations is mandatory and if any non-compliance is observed, the approval will not be granted.
 - the appointment of deficient staff will not be considered as a compliance during the appeal period.

10. Please note that -

- if the details are found missing (not filled) / incorrect / false / non-compliance of the prescribed statutory provisions is observed, the application will not be processed for approval leading to "No Admission Year" for the institution and the Principal may also be debarred from holding any administrative position in future.
- the PCI will not be responsible for the above consequences and hence due caution be exercised while filling the SIF and submission to PCI.
- submission of above-mentioned statutory documents is a pre-requisite mandatory requirement.
- in the absence of submission of pre-requisite mandatory documents as detailed above, application will be rejected for introduction of new course, raise in admission and services.

11. It is also clarified that no hard copy of the application in SIF will be accepted. The institutions have to apply online only on PCI portal.

Sir/Madam

1. The Pharmacy Council of India is a statutory body working under the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India. It is constituted under the Pharmacy Act, 1948 and is entrusted with the responsibility of approval of pharmacy courses for the purpose of registration as a pharmacist to practice the profession.
2. As empowered u/s 10 of the Pharmacy Act, the PCI has framed the statutory Regulations for various pharmacy courses with the approval of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India and notified them in the Gazette.
3. At present, the following Regulations are in vogue -
 - a) The Education Regulations, 2020 for Diploma Course in Pharmacy.
 - b) The Bachelor of Pharmacy (B.Pharm) Course Regulations, 2014.
 - c) The Master of Pharmacy (M.Pharm) Course Regulations, 2014.
 - d) Pharm.D. Regulations, 2008.
 - e) Bachelor of Pharmacy (Practice) Regulations, 2014.
 - f) Minimum Qualification for Teachers in Pharmacy Institutions Regulations, 2014.
 - g) Pharmacy Practice Regulations, 2015.These Regulations are available on Council's website www.pci.nic.in
4. For the purpose of consideration of approval of pharmacy courses, the PCI has framed the "Schemes" for each course which are available on Council's website under the tab "Procedure/Forms". As per the said schemes, the following statutory documents are mandatory for -
 - a) introduction of any new pharmacy course in the existing institution.
 - b) starting of new pharmacy institution in the States / Union Territories which are exempted from Council's moratorium. (For moratorium, please refer to Council's circular dt.17.7.2019 and 9.9.2019 as available on Council's website. The Council has imposed moratorium on opening of new Diploma and Degree institutions from 2020-2021 academic session for a period of 5 years).

5. The documents to be submitted mandatorily at the time of application for consideration are -

a) **For B.Pharm course**

- i) Consent of affiliation of Examining Authority.
- ii) NOC of the State Government.

In case, the State Government has done away with the issuance of NOC of the State Government for starting of pharmacy course, in that case institution shall upload the said communication from the State Government as a documentary evidence.

b) **For D.Pharm / Pharm.D & Pharm.D (Post Baccalaureate) / new M.Pharm course and introduction of new M.Pharm specialization / B.Pharm (Practice) course**

- Consent of affiliation of the Examining Authority.
- MOU with 300 bedded hospital (applicable for Pharm.D course) in the prescribed format.

6. As per judgement dt.13.12.2012 passed by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Parshavanath Charitable Trust, the regulatory bodies concerned with grant of approval has to complete the approval process by 10th of April and appeal process by 30th of April every year.

7. The PCI is planning to open the portal for online submission of applications for 2022-2023 approval cycle in due course of time.

8. In view of above -


a) all the State Governments and Examining Authorities are requested to complete the process of issuance of following documents to pharmacy institutions for 2022-2023 academic session so as to comply with the deadline fixed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court -

- i) NOC of the State Government.
- ii) Consent of affiliation of the Examining Authority.

b) all pharmacy institutions are requested to make sure that they are able to obtain the above cited statutory documents (wherever applicable) and submit the same along with the online SIF.

The kind support of all the stakeholders is solicited in the matter for smooth completion of approval process for 2022-2023 academic session to avoid unnecessary litigations and comply with the deadline fixed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

With reference to the subject cited above, I am directed to inform that subject cited issue was considered by 93/CC in its meeting held in July, 2013 which noted that in some cases teaching faculty either resign or/are terminated during the academic session which adversely effects the quality of education.

In view of above, it was decided to instruct the pharmacy institutions that –

- a) the teaching faculty whose name is shown at the time of inspection and approval is granted by the PCI on the basis of availability of the said teaching staff will not be eligible to join other institutions during the same academic year. Hence staff who have resigned or terminated by the management on grounds other than the criminal misconduct during the currency of the said academic session will not be taken to count while granting approval for such institutions.
- b) in the event of any dispute the matter shall be referred to the PCI.
