Mr. Mahesh Sachdeva, Industrialist, appreciated the discussions and suggested for industry exposure to the students.	
21.3.	Course Outcomes (COs) and Program Outcome (POs) of Courses	Few Departments are yet to implement CO's & PO's in the respective Departments. The student Members Ms. Rivika Jain and Mr. Rohit Chauhan requested to share the PO's & CO's in the syllabus and share with the stakeholders.	

		The PVC advised the IQAC to take the initiative to conduct a workshop on Outcome Based Education for all the faculty members.
21.4.	Status of No. of Value Added Courses	The Value Added Courses (VAC) to be conducted during 2021-22 towards curriculum enrichment were shared by the respective HoDs. A total of 40 plus VAC courses will be offered across all Departments.  Mr. Ayush Vashishtha appreciated the initiative and suggested that the VAC should be offered in the emerging areas with an aim to bridge the gap between industry and academics. Mr. Mahesh Sachdeva suggested to make provisions for the students to visit nearby industries for good exposure as a part of Value Added Learning.  Hon'ble PVC acknowledged the suggestions from the members and requested the HoDs to fetch the support of T&P Cell for offering short-term internship modules during all years of the respective Programmes.
21.5.	Status of submission of Event completion report	The IQAC Director apprised to the Chair and the members that all the Departments are following the process of submitting complete Event completion reports as per the formats circulated. Hon'ble PVC appreciated the initiative and advised to continue the same practice henceforth.
21.6	Measures taken for Faculty Retention	The HR Manager informed the members that several schemes/policies focusing on research incentives, employee wards, flexi hours, medical claims have been framed and implemented from the academic year 2021-22.
